IKEA NOW OPEN The much anticipated IKEA is open, as is the two-story food hall (Saluhall), cooking school (Cookery Skola), and co-working space (Hej!Workshop); the building is complete with on-site, indoor parking.

CONVENIENT, EASY ACCESS Mid Market is bookended by Powell Street and Civic Center BART/MUNI regional transit stations. Autos have access to 19 nearby parking garages. Flat and pedestrian friendly, Mid Market also features vintage streetcars on the F-line, popular with tourists and locals alike.

MORE PEOPLE ARE LIVING IN MID MARKET New residential developments such as: Serif, Prism, 50 Jones, Trinity Place, and NEMA contributed to a 14% increase in residents living in the Mid Market area, which includes parts of SOMA and Civic Center.
